Nero Burning Rom Ver. 5

1. With Nero Burning rom version 5.0; Open the program, click the Help menu, help topics.
Click the Contents tab. To open any Book, double click the one you are interested in.
2. Decide what you want to do!
 - Recording a CD with NERO
 - Image file
 - Burning hard disk backups with Nero
 - CD-Copy
 - Saving tracks with Nero
 - Miscellaneous
 - FAQ's
 - More Help

There, you'll find the files with a [?] in front. Open the file, then click the Print button on top.
You now have a hard copy of the Step by Step Instructions, a (Handout) to do that task.
The Nero ver. 6.0 program is really self explanatory.

Roxio easy CD & DVD Creator 6

Open the program!
Click on Disk Creator Classic!
Click "Help", Creator Classic Help!
Click the Contents tab!

There you'll find Books and files [?] in front, just like in Nero above.
The procedures are the same.

Those pointers and procedures are true for most Burning Programs.

Personally, I like to start with creating Image files,
that way you can change things if you want, before burning them onto a CD.

With Clone CD

Windows Media Player

With Windows Media Player, it is very simple to just assemble a Playlist, then copy it directly to a CD and burn it. To find out how?

Click on "Help", Help Topics, Contents tab,

Ver. 7, **Copying music to your portable device.**

Ver. 8, **Using Windows Media Player, Copying files to your portable device.**

Ver. 9, **"Common tasks", to create your own CD.**

There, You find several pages you can print out.

For instance: In version 7.01 Click Help, Using WMP, Copying and playing CD's, **Creating your own CD's, To create your own CD**

To create your own CD

1. On the **File** menu, click **Copy to CD**.
2. Select the playlist that you want to copy, then click **OK**

Note: You must copy tracks for the CD you want to create to the **Media Library**, and you must create a playlist of these tracks before creating a CD.

For more information, see **Related Topics**.

The items in your playlist should be no more than 74 minutes long or 650MB.

3. Follow the instructions on your screen.
