

Tuning up Your computer.

1. Clean out the temporary internet folder
Internet Explorer
Netscape
2. Empty out all the temp folders
3. get rid of all unnecessary TSR's
4. boot into SAFE MODE
turn off the screen saver program.
5. Run SCANDISK in SAFE MODE
6. Run DEFRAG also in SAFE MODE

Sprucing up Your Resources

To find out the available resources on the Computer after bootup.

Right click MY COMPUTER, PROPERTIES, PERFORMANCE

If the Resources are less than 90% after booting, get rid of some of the TSR's

Turning off the TSR's (Terminate and Stay Resident Programs)

which are not necessary and take up valuable resources.

Click Start, Run, type in MSconfig and click OK,

the System Configuration Utility window will open! Click the Start tab!

There, the Startup Menu is visible.

Only those programs which are necessary to run the computer should be checked! All others should be unchecked!

The programs which must stay checked are:

Scan Registry, Pointer(Mouse), System Tray,
and the autoprotect anti virus Program.

All others, click the check mark to uncheck them!

Now, reboot your system and check the free Resource percentage!
