Step by step series

## The Sound Recorder

Go to START, PROGRAMS, ACCESSORIES, ENTERTAINMENT, SOUND RECORDER.

- To record:

Click the button with the red Dot and start talking!  
When finish, click the button with the black rectangle.

- To play back:

Click the button with the black triangle.

- To save your file:

Click FILE, SAVE AS.

Save as window is open! Click the down arrow and find the folder where you want to save your new sound file in.

Set the cursor in the File Name window, and type a name. Click the SAVE button.

What can you do with that new \*.wav file?

Well, send it via Email to some one you love, as an attachment. Or put it into windows so that it'll play at Startup!?

Let's demonstrate the latter!

Go to START, SETTINGS, CONTROL PANEL, SOUNDS.

With the Sounds Properties window open.

Scroll to Start Windows and highlight it!

Click the BROWSE button and find the Folder where you saved that \*.wav file.

Click that file, it then shows in the name window!

Click apply and OK.

Now, instead having the windows startup sound, play at start up, you'll have your own recording do the Introduction of Windows.

The same way, one can have all the event-sounds changed to your own sound creations.
